2015 PAYROLL RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Canton to pay a competitive wage to attract and retain the best employees to effectively and responsibly serve the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canton, as an employer, makes periodic adjustments to wages and compensation for inflation, regulatory requirements, and in comparison to other employers; and

WHEREAS, Full-Time Police Personnel's Hourly Rate is based on a work schedule of 2,184 hour/year, and all other City Full-time Personnel's Hourly Rate is based on a work schedule of 2080 hours/year.
