5th Street (HWY 18) from the existing lift station to Blair Street & 2nd Street from Main Street to the cul-de-sac

Over the past two weeks the contractor completed all the underground utility work and the grading of the dirt subgrade along 2nd Street. The Contractor also completed installing the storm sewer inlets along the project.

Due to high moisture contents in the soil, the Contractor over-excavated several areas and installed pavement fabric to help support the new asphalt pavement. New gravel was placed and new concrete curb and gutter was installed as needed along 2nd Street.

The following work is anticipated over the next couple of weeks.

- Complete installation and grading of the new gravel
- Install asphalt surfacing along 2nd Street
- Install new concrete sidewalk and driveway approaches as needed
- Install topsoil then seed, fertilize and mulch the disturbed areas outside of the street surfacing

The contractor expects to be completed with the work on 2nd Street by the middle of August 2014. **This is only an estimate and may vary due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.**
